



# PANAMA 2026 CDLC Tour

### 1. EVENT DATES

Thursday April 23 - Sunday April 26, 2026 / Panama City, Panama

### 2. TOURNAMENT VENUE

Hotel El Panamá, Eusebio A. Morales St & España Av., El Cangrejo, Panama City

### 3. ENTRY FEES

**World Cup Regional Qualifier Final (Friday): \$100 USD per team** (With a maximum of 3 teams per country entered into the qualifier.)

**Weekend 1 Events Qualifiers (Thursday-Saturday-Sunday): \$150 USD per person**

### 4. PRIZE FUND

**World Championship Prizes:** Each Main Event will have an identical prize fund.

**Winner:** \$820 + 18 Tour Points

**Runner Up:** \$420 + 12 Tour Points

**Last 4:** \$180 + 8 Tour Points

**Last 8:** \$80 + 6 Tour Points

**Last 16:** \$0 + 4 Tour Points

**Last 32:** \$0 + 2 Tour Points

**Last 64:** \$0 + 1 Tour Point

**Last 128:** \$0 + ½ Tour Point

#### **World Cup Regional Qualifier Final**

**Winner:** Guaranteed to receive the minimum payout at the PDC World Cup of Darts (£5,000 GBP per team).  
\*Payouts will be made by the PDC within 14 days of completion of the event and full information will be communicated to all players by the PDC.

**Runner Up:** 40% of entry fees (per team)

**Last 4:** 10% of entry fees (per team)



## 5. CDLC TOUR FORMAT

**CDLC Order of Merit System:** Points will be accumulated at each Tour Weekend Events based on the above criteria. The player at the top of the OOM after the final event in Bahamas will qualify for the PDC World Darts Championship held at London's Alexandra Palace, starting in December.

Order of Merit points will be accumulated for two years. This ranking will be used to seed the top 16 ranked players in upcoming CDLC Tour events.

## 6. EVENT TIMES AND GAME SYSTEM

**Registration / check-in closes ONE HOUR PRIOR to listed start time for each event.**

Registration will be handled on-site, and payment must be made in cash in either US Dollars or the equivalent in local currency.

THE DRAW WILL BE CONDUCTED ON THE DAY OF EACH EVENT EXCEPT THE WORLD CUP QUALIFIER WHICH WILL BE DRAWN LIVE ON OR BEFORE FRIDAY 17 APRIL AND ANNOUNCED IN ADVANCE. Teams to be submitted no later than 10 April. All players must check-in by the indicated cut-off times above or they may not be included in the draw.

**2025 CDLC Tour Event 1:** Best of 11 legs, Single Elimination

### Friday 24 April, 2026 – 3:00 PM

**CDLC World Cup of Darts Qualifier Final:** All matches will be doubles / pairs format. (Only qualified teams will be allowed to play this tournament. Each country can qualify a maximum of 3 teams)

- Group Stage - Best of 7 legs (Round Robin four or more Groups)
- Quarter Finals – Best of 9 legs
- Semi-Finals - Best of 15 legs
- Final - Best of 19 legs

### Saturday 25 April, 2026 – 1:00 PM

**2025 CDLC Tour Event 2:** Best of 11 legs, Single Elimination

### Sunday 26 April, 2026 – 1:00 PM

**2025 CDLC Tour Event 3:** Best of 11 legs, Single Elimination



## 7. GENERAL RULES

### WHO CAN PLAY

The CDLC Tour will be open to:

- a) Players aged 16 and above;
- b) Citizen from the following nations: Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Aruba, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Cayman Islands, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Curacao, Dominica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Granada, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Martin, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, Turks and Caicos, Uruguay, Venezuela;
- c) Players with dual nationality must choose one of the countries of which they are nationals and may not change countries for the next 5 years;
- d) Permanent residents of a foreign country or persons who do not have a passport of the country they wish to represent. They should have been legally residing in the country for more than 5 years (once a player registers in this manner with a country, he/she will not be able to change countries for the next 5 years);

### MATCHES

All games will be straight start, finish on a double and the center bull will count as double 25.

### ORDER OF PLAY

All matches will begin with a shot for bull. The player on the left/top of the bracket MUST throw first for the bull (no coin toss).

Darts which land outside the 25 or 50 segments will not be measured. Only darts which land within the inner or outer bull will count – should both players fail to hit the inner or outer bull or tie with a 25/50, they will throw again in reverse order until the start has been won. Two darts in the 25 will tie as will two darts in the 50.

All darts at the bull must be removed by the player throwing the dart immediately following their throw so that the following player has a clean field at which to shoot.

The players that win the bull start the odd-numbered legs. Loser starts all even-numbered legs. There will be no re-bull for a tiebreak/deciding leg.



## DRESS CODE

All players must wear a collared shirt with no vulgarities or obscene displays.

Dress pants or khakis must be worn for play. No jeans, tennis shoes or other casual trousers are allowed while playing your tournament matches.

Footwear must be dress shoes or all-black sneakers (with NO OTHER COLOR VISIBLE). Any player who wishes to deviate from the standard dark trousers, black footwear dress code must consult with the Tournament Director in advance of the event to obtain permission and should be prepared with standard clothing should permission not be given.

## PLAYERS OBLIGATIONS

**ALL players MUST be present at the venue at one hour prior to their matches**, must check in with tournament officials, and be in playing attire.

**\*\*\*Please note\*\*\* that travel difficulties or family commitments will not be accepted as a reason for lateness or non-attendance.**

## PLAYER BEHAVIOR

Players are reminded that it is their own responsibility to always behave in an acceptable manner so as to not bring the sport into disrepute.

Players must not drink alcohol while playing Tour Matches. Violation of this rule may result in disciplinary action up to and including disqualification from the event and ejection from the venue.

If necessary, the Tournament Director has the power to stop a game and award the match to the opponent of any player whom the Tournament Director decides is behaving in a way which is damaging to the sport, the CDLC, its sponsors or tournament officials.

## CODE OF CONDUCT

By agreeing to participate in this event, players agree to the rules of the Darts Regulation Authority (DRA), including the Code of Conduct. As an affiliate of the Championship Darts Corporation, CDLC events must be run in accordance with DRA rules. The full DRA rulebook can be found at <http://www.thedra.co.uk>.



## 8. INFORMATION OF INTEREST

### OFFICIAL HOTEL

### TRANSPORTATION

Uber is readily available in Panama City and can easily be arranged. It is the way of transport recommended by the organization. Cheaper than taxis and better service.

From the airport to the Hotel/Venue it takes 25-30 minutes and the cost is \$20-\$25 for 4pax. Uber XL is just around \$5 extra for the ride and can hold up to 7pax.

At the airport you can find also taxis, rental cars and metro (\$2.85/person but it takes like +1h)

If your delegation has a large group of people, you can contact the organizing committee to help you coordinate special transportation.

### VISA

All participants who are neither citizens of Panama nor have legal residence in the country must have a valid passport and the appropriate visa to enter Panama. As requirements vary, participants should contact the nearest Panamanian embassy or consulate for information on the appropriate visa procedures.

If participants have difficulties in obtaining their visas, they are advised to contact the organizing committee.



## **OFFICIAL CURRENCY**

United States Dollar (USD)

You can pay by card everywhere. Visa and Mastercard are recommended, as American Express is not accepted in many places.

## **TAXES AND TIPS**

Value-added tax (VAT) is 7%. Visitors generally leave a 10% tip (e.g., in restaurants). Panama's hotels apply a 10% service tax.

## **OFFICIAL LANGUAGE**

The official language of Panama is Spanish. English is widely used.

## **TIME ZONE**

Panama is in time zone (GTM -5) NY, Bogota, Lima, Quito

## **WEATHER**

Panama's weather is exactly what you'd expect from a tropical country: warm and humid year round, with wet and dry seasons. Translated, this means temperatures in the upper 70s to mid-80s, for the most part, and humidity levels near 80 percent. April will be end of dry season.

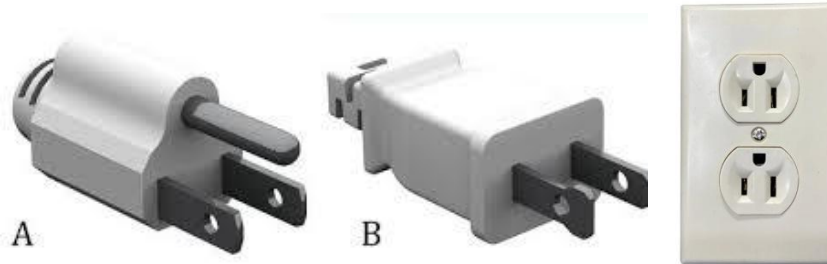

## CELL PHONE SERVICE

Nowadays many telephone companies offer roaming service in the region. If your provider does not offer roaming, the best thing to do is to buy a prepaid SIM card. You can contract internet packages for 3 or 7 days and it's really cheap.

These cards cost \$1 plus the cost of the package of your preference. These can be purchased at the company stores, at the airport or in hotels and local stores. \*\*\*Avoid scams at the airport who charge you much more than the \$1 for the card.
